Ballantrae School

Also known as Ballantrae Parochial/Parish School.
In 1739 interest of £500 was left to be applied to educate poor children by Duchess De Coigny Trust and the Kirk Session of Ballantrae. The schoolroom was built c1810 although the actual building predated that by 100 years and was in need of repair. In 1849 the school had 2 male pupil teachers. It became a junior secondary after World War II but was downgraded to a primary on 26 June 1964.
