Belonged to Dalmellington Iron Works Company. Established c1874. Premises used for divine service fortnightly. Teacher William Guthrie born 1848 taught at Eglinton Iron Company School, and Cronberry School. School discontinued 23 November 1951.

Waterside School, Dalmellington

Also known as Waterside Primary School and formerly known as Dalmellington Ironworks School. The school was established in 1864 by the Dalmellington Iron Company. The premises were rented from them for £75. The school was managed by the manager of the iron works and the parish minister. In 1864 the teachers were Donald Ross aged 25 formerly at Wishaw Public School; Betsy Gordon aged 24; the assistant teacher was David Anderson. The site was feued in 1848 from the Dalmellington Iron Company for 999 years. The original buildings were wooden but a new building was erected in 1864. The school was renamed St. Xaviers Roman Catholic Primary School on 8 June 1959.
