Annick Lodge Primary, Irvine

Also known as Annick Lodge Coal Works School and Annick Lodge Public School, Irvine Parish
Belonged to Merry and Cunninghame, Glengarnock Iron Works.
Established 1863 and managed by general manager of the works and teacher. Fees were 2½d a week. Teachers house was not attached to the school. 1st teacher William Barbour appointed 17 April 1863, trained at Free Church Normal Seminary, Glasgow and was assistant at Glengarnock Iron Works School.

East Road School, Irvine

Also known as Irvine Public and Industrial School. Deed for land 12 June 1860 in burgage in perpetuity. Teachers (1859) were James Goudie aged 32 and Mary MacKenzie aged 23. School was established in 1814 under Royal Burgh of Irvine to educate poor and deprived children. Buildings used were erected c1750. Became known as Irvine East Road Primary School c1935. Closed Jan 1938. Records do not record name changes.
