Ground under feu disposition by Duke of Portland, 17 January 1867. Run by committee of Kilmarnock Town Council. School erected 1868. Teacher (1869) Peter Anderson aged 22 formerly at Newton on Ayr.

Crookedholm Public School was established c1876 under the Kilmarnock (Landward) School Board. The teachers were Thomas Duncanson who taught at Grougar and Jeanie I Duncanson.
