Fergushill School, Kilwinning

Previously Fergushill Colliery School and Fergushill Public School, Kilwinning Parish.

The original buildings belonged to Lord Eglinton and Messrs. Archibald Finnie and Son Limited. The school was established c1836 when Archibald Finnie was the sole manager and directly employed the teacher. It was also used as a preaching station and Sabbath school. Buildings were erected in 1858 and 1866. Teacher (1853) was Andrew Thomson born 1828 aged 26. The School Board took over management on 26 May 1874.
