Tarbolton Primary

Formerly Tarbolton Subscription School.

This was erected by public subscription and was held in trust by a committee. The deed erecting it was dated 1859. The building was erected in 1858 with a slate roof. In 1860 the teacher was Alex Oliver aged 28 years. It replaced Tarbolton Parochial School which had been built in 1808, and was built of wood. In 1858 the teachers were Robert Walker aged 75 who accepted a retiring allowance and the assistant teacher was Robert Marshall aged 21. It became a junior secondary after World War II.

School is listed as having records in the 1983 survey, however in 2012, after contact with the school secretary who thought the records had been transferred to the County Buildings, archives were unable to trace these records.
