AA/DC99/1/2	1912	From James Wylie, millwright and agricultural implement maker of Crosshill to James Gibson Esquire, solicitor Royal Bank Maybole. Regarding change in the specification of the repairs to the water wheel at Dunduff, and increase in prices
AA/DC99/1/3	7 May 1913	From James Wylie, millwright and agricultural implement maker of Crosshill to Dunure Estate being the invoice for repairing water wheel, new trows and mason work at Dunduff. Stamped and signed 14 June 1913

AA/DC99/7	1916	From J F Gordon, slater and glazier, Maybole to John G Kennedy Esquire, of Dunure, per Brown and Gibson. Lists repairs undertaken at steading at East Threave, Dalquharran Castle, Heather Row, Romilly Cottage and Gate House
AA/DC99/8	1918	From John Cameron, ironmonger and seedsman, Maybole to J Campbell Kennedy Esquire, Dalquharran for supplying the gardens, various items
AA/DC99/9	1919	From John Kerr, plasterer, and cement merchant, Maybole to Brown and Gibson, Factors for J C Kennedy, Esquire of Dunure for supplying goods to J Brannan, thatcher on Dalquharran Estate
