**PR Pupil Record Cards**

These Pupil Record Cards are in index card format with information handwritten onto a pre printed card. One card exists for each pupil. They record the date of admission, the subjects studied and grades achieved. The majority include a black and white photograph of the pupil which was taken during their first year. The cards are arranged in alphabetical order by the date of leaving. Please note that researchers have to search using the pupil leaving date rather than their admission. The cards exist in this format until 2003 when the records were subsequently created in electronic format. Current records are with the school.

**KA Pupil Progress Records**

These records contain administrative information about the pupils including name, date of birth, address, name of parent or guardian, name of family doctor and previous schools they attended. Some of the information on these cards is incomplete, some of the records also contain a photograph of the pupil.
