

AA/DC157**Cunningham of Enterkine****Legal Documents and Correspondence**

AA/DC157/1	16 August 1643	Execution of letters of poinding and apprising at the instance of Robert Scott, assignee against Hew Dunbar now of Enterkin over the lands of Moor of Mauchline sometime called Tawfauldschaw, tenement of land within the town of Mauchline and all within the lordship and barony of Kylesmuir, half merk land of Dyik with three roods of the meadow thereof, half merk land of Brunb[urn], 12 acres of mill lands with piece of meadow, corn mill of Enterkine etc.
AA/DC157/2	28 June 1710	Extract registered mortification by John Cunningham of Enterkine to provide an English school and schoolmaster for the town of Tarbolton to make payments at Whitsun and Martinmas to Mr James Brackenridge, present schoolmaster of Tarbolton. Endorsed by John Cunningham on 20 October 1740 saying that the mortification never came into effect (2 pages). Fragile
AA/DC157/3	21 September 1713	Demission of the office of schoolmaster of Tarbolton by William McCornock in favour of [John Cunningham] of Enterkine. At Tarbolton before Mr Henry Osborne, minister of Tarbolton and Patrick Hay, clerk in Mauchline
AA/DC157/4	22 August 1743	Letter from James Forrester in London to William Cunningham mentioning the loss of his previous letters due to the activities of a Spanish privateer, Mr Wentworth and Mr St Clair are desirous of his being recalled, only successful in getting his appointments as engineer doubled, trying to get him reappointed to Rattan, brutality of Jenny Dalrymple's husband towards her, Dr and Mrs Cochrane's regards
AA/DC157/5	21 March 1741	Instrument of intimation and removing at the instance of John Cunningham of Enterkine against John Alexander, schoolmaster in Tarbolton from the offices of schoolmaster, precentor and session clerk because Alexander was not resident in Tarbolton and had neglected the school. Done in the house of Hugh Manson, weaver in Tarbolton, in presence of James Dun in Whitehill, Hugh Manson and [] Gairdner, notary public
